New SQL Server 2022 updates build on a decade of consistent innovation

DECADE OF INNOVATION

Since 2012, we have continuously reinvested in driving unparalleled value in SQL Server and have developed 50 new capabilities into the product:

- **Released SQL Server 2016** with 14 new capabilities including support for PolyBase, JSON, Basic High Availability & Row Level Security
- **Released SQL Server 2017** with 10 new innovations including Support for Linux (RedHat, SUSE & Ubuntu), Python & R language capabilities, & support for Docker containers
- **Released SQL Server 2019** which included 12 additions Data Virtualization for external data sources and intelligent database enhancements
- **Releasing SQL Server 2022** with 14 new innovations including links to Azure SQL Managed Instance, Synapse & Purview, and a Pay-As-You-Go (PAYG) purchasing model

PERFORMANCE, SECURITY & GOVERNANCE

Performance, security & governance are critical concerns for most customers, and SQL Server 2022 addresses these in new product capabilities:

Microsoft Purview integration with SQL Server 2022 enables visibility over your entire data estate

- Automatically scan on-prem SQL Server to capture metadata across multiple SQL deployments edge to cloud
- Classify data using built-in and custom classifiers and Microsoft Information Protection sensitivity labels
- Set up and control specific access rights to SQL Server

Azure Synapse Link for SQL Server 2022 provides automatic change feeds that capture the changes within SQL Server

- Break the wall between operational & analytical stores
- New change feed capability reduces impact on OLTP workloads
- Near real-time latency between SQL Server and Synapse Analytics
- Analyze all your data using both Spark and SQL runtimes in Synapse

UPDATE TO LIST PRICE

Our first substantive change to the list price since SQL Server 2012

Starting January 1, 2023, all channels will have a price increase:

- Volume Licensing (VL): 10%
 - Includes EA, ESU, USG, ISV, EES (CC, SC), OLV, OVS, Select, Select+, NGVL
- CSP: 10%
- VSS: 10%
- MCPPP: 10%
- MBS: 10%
- MS Store (Retail): 10%
- OEM & IoT: 10%
- SPLA: 8% on Ent. Edition, 10% on Std. & Web editions
- Please note this price change does impact all public sector customers, worldwide

There will be a 10% price increase on all SQL on-prem SKUs, *including SA SKUs*

There will be no change to Azure SQL IP pay-as-you-go pricing

Partner Guidance for SQL Server 2022 (incl. price change)

The launch of SQL Server 2022 brings to market a host of new innovations and expanded capabilities including Azure connectivity, data security, performance, & governance! This launch also includes the first price change for SQL Server in a decade, in the form of a 10% price change affecting *only* the on-premises versions of SQL Server.

Guidance for Partners:

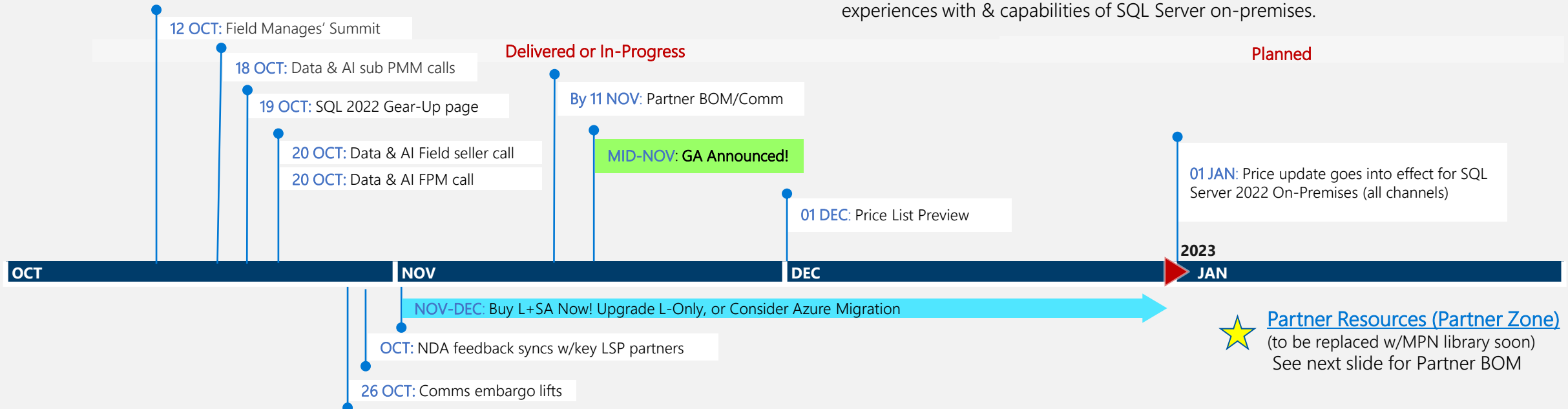
1. Reach out to your SQL Server customers right away and talk with them about purchasing/upgrading now (before the price change goes into effect on January 1, 2023)
2. Start your customer conversations with a focus on the business & technology requirements of their app/data platform – from this you can determine if they will choose to (or be required to) purchase or continue using on-premises versions of SQL Server. Land the value of SQL Server 2022 and new and existing Software Assurance benefits.
3. If price change becomes a customer issue/blocker, discuss migration alternatives such as migration to Azure SQL or PAYG via Azure Arc Enabled Data Services

1 Oct 2022 – Jan 2023 – “L+SA Buy Now”, upgrade L-Only, or consider Azure

- Engage with customers with no Software Assurance (L-Only) or net new customers (L+SA) **before Jan 1, 2023**. Use Q2 as time to upgrade L-Only customers to SA or drive new L+SA purchases of SQL w/price change as the sense of urgency.
- **Move on-prem customers to Azure SQL or new PAYG model** (neither of which will be affected by the price change).
- **Ensure all near-term customer quotes for SQL Server show Dec. 31, 2022 as the expiration date** (and include a note that the price will change as of January 1, 2023)

2 After January 1, 2023 – Focus on new customers & Azure migration opps

- Continue driving high value of SQL Server 2022 innovations w/new customers. In recent surveys, SQL Server (on-prem) showed higher developer affinity than our Azure data services offerings, so don't overlook this opportunity to continue growing our base.
- **Leverage post-price change timeframe to drive customer consideration of data migration options.** Maintain strong sales focus on driving customer understanding of the value of cloud adoption, including hybrid scenarios (Arc) to enhance their experiences with & capabilities of SQL Server on-premises.
